AN AMENDED
PETITION FOR
PROBATE has been
filed by Jesse Victor
Romero in the Superior
Court of California,
County of SAN BER-
NARDINO.

THE AMENDED
PETITION FOR
PROBATE requests that
Jesse Victor Romero be
appointed as personal
representative to ad-
minister the estate of the
decendent.

THE AMENDED
PETITION requests the
decendent's lost will and
codicils, if any, be
admitted to probate.
Copies of the lost will
and any codicils are
available for examina-
tion in the file kept by
the court.

THE AMENDED
PETITION requests
authority to administer
the estate under the
Independent Admin-
istration of Estates Act.
(This authority will
allow the personal
representative to take
many actions without
obtaining court approval.
Before taking certain
very important actions,
however, the personal
representative will be
required to give notice
to interested persons
unless they have waived
notice or consented to
the proposed action.)
The independent ad-
ministration authority
will be granted unless an
interested person files
an objection to the

petition and shows good
cause why the court
should not grant the
authority.

A HEARING on
the amended petition
will be held on June 28,
2023 at 9:00 AM in
Dept. No. S35 located at
247 W. Third St., San
Bernardino, CA 92415.

IF YOU OBJECT
to the granting of the
petition, you should
appear at the hearing
and state your objec-
tions or file written
objections with the
court before the hearing.
Your appearance may
be in person or by your
attorney.

IF YOU ARE A
CREDITOR or a con-
tingent creditor of the
decendent, you must file
your claim with the
court and mail a copy to
the personal representa-
tive appointed by the
court within the later of
either (1) four months
from the date of first
issuance of letters to a
general personal repre-
sentative, as defined in
section 58(b) of the
California Probate Code,
or (2) 60 days from the
date of mailing or per-
sonal delivery to you of
a notice under section
9052 of the California
Probate Code.

Other California
statutes and legal au-
thority may affect your
rights as a creditor. You
may want to consult
with an attorney
knowledgeable in Cali-
fornia law.

YOU MAY EX-
AMINE the file kept by
the court. If you are a
person interested in the
estate, you may file with
the court a Request for
Special Notice (form
DE-154) of the filing of
an inventory and ap-
praisal of estate assets or
of any petition or ac-
count as provided in
Probate Code section
1250. A Request for
Special Notice form is
available from the court
clerk.
